



Description of the selection procedure

General

The application file must include:

- Brief CV (personal information, degree, position, university/organization,...);
- Motivation letter for participating to European Train-the-trainer event in radiation protection (Max 500 Words).

Please note that the number of supported participants to the Train-the-trainer event is limited to 10 participants in total. Only full-time participation is accepted to be eligible for funding.

Criteria for ranking of the applicants

All applicants are handled equally regardless of nationality, ethnicity, gender, and age.

1. According to the ENEN2plus Mobility Manual, eligible applicants are persons performing a transnational mobility action;
2. Suitability of background education: participants must be students, interested young professionals who are completing a voluntary scientific year in the field, or early career professionals. An equal representation of these profiles will be sought in order to guarantee a good mix between participants' backgrounds in accordance to the objectives of the event;
3. The potential merit for attending this train-the-trainer event (e.g. if the candidate already is or has the potential to be involved as a trainer in training courses regarding radiation protection)
4. Motivation letter;
5. Command of the English language.
