

## Description of the selection procedure

## General

The application file must include:

- Brief CV (personal information, degree, position, university/organization,...);
- Motivation letter for participating to European Train-the-trainer event in radiation protection (Max 500 Words).

Please note that the number of supported participants to the Train-the-trainer event is limited to 10 participants in total. Only full-time participation is accepted to be eligible for funding.

## Criteria for ranking of the applicants

All applicants are handled equally regardless of nationality, ethnicity, gender, and age.

- 1. According to the ENEN2plus Mobility Manual, eligible applicants are persons performing a <u>transnational</u> mobility action;
- 2. Suitability of background education: participants must be <u>students</u>, <u>interested young professionals</u> who are completing a voluntary scientific year in the field, or <u>early career professionals</u>. An equal representation of these profiles will be sought in order to guarantee a good mix between participants' backgrounds in accordance to the objectives of the event;
- 3. The <u>potential merit</u> for attending this train-the-trainer event (e.g. if the candidate already is or has the potential to be involved as a trainer in training courses regarding radiation protection)
- 4. Motivation letter;
- 5. Command of the English language.

Members of Steering Committee are from EUTERP, POLIMI and AIRP.
